SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION</div><div>After the nominated student has been approved by UW-Stout and the partner university, the student must complete all required application materials and submit them to their home institution's study abroad office.</div><div>3. AFTER ADMISSION

Visa Application & Information	<p>To enter the U.S., students will need their DS-2019, passport and visa. To apply for the J-1 visa (exchange visitor visa), visit www.fmifree.com and submit the SEVIS I-901 form along with payment in order to be granted an interview with a consular official. Visa applicants will need the SEVIS ID number located on the DS-2019.</p> <p>Exchange students are encouraged to apply for their visa early to avoid delay in securing an appointment!</p>

Required Account Activations	Upon acceptance, students must complete their Student Account Activation and the Student Account Contract . Completion of these is essential as students will not be able to enroll in courses or university housing until they have been completed. Students will be sent instructions to complete these steps in the acceptance letter.

	Students who arrive earlier than the official move-in date of the on-campus dormitory must arrange their own accommodations until then. Once travel plans are confirmed, students must complete the Arrival Information Form . Information from this form will be used to assist the student with their arrival.			
Dormitory Application	Once the student's UW-Stout email account has been activated, a University Housing application will be sent to the student's Stout email account. Students should complete this as soon as possible. Dining plans are also requested through this application.			
Off-Campus Housing	If a student wishes to obtain off-campus housing, they are required to do so before coming to the US. It is the sole responsibility of the student and will not be the responsibility of the Office of International Education.			
Tuition and Dormitory Payment	Students are advised not pay their tuition and fees until at least the second week of the semester. This is because there may be changes to their account when they first arrive. Information about payment methods can be found here . Tuition and fees are due in the sixth week of the semester.			
Course Registration Restrictions	Students can select courses from any discipline at UW-Stout but will face registration restrictions in the following circumstances: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the course pre-requisites not met (as indicated on the transcript) • Course enrollment is already full (this can sometimes be changed) • Placement test results do not place student into requested course • If student requests enrollment in the following reserved course numbers: • x49, x77, x97, x98, x99, 735, 770, 795, 895. These numbers are reserved for field experiences and graduate-level thesis coursework. 			
Health Insurance	J-1 exchange visitors are required to carry an insurance policy that meets minimum standards of coverage. Because of this, students will be automatically enrolled in a mandatory health insurance policy. This is a platinum coverage policy that represents excellent coverage at a reasonable price. Information about the policy will be provided during orientation and is also available upon request. Please note that it is not possible to waive the health insurance enrollment.			
Arriving in Menomonie	For transportation from Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport (MSP) to Menomonie, Wisconsin, students are encouraged to make a reservation with the Groome Transportation . Groome provides a shuttle service from MSP to Menomonie. Students should submit their flight itinerary including arrival date, time, airport and flight number on the Arrival Information Form so that staff can assist them with their arrival.
